Important Information for Referrers of Older Persons where there is suspected/confirmed Elder Abuse present

Service update

Due to the increasing complexity, intensity and volume of cases, BPA is temporarily closing new referrals for a period of 4 weeks. This decision is necessary to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our current clients and to allow our practitioners to work within safe practice limits.

What referrers need to know

During this period, please be aware of the following:

- **Current Clients**: We are focusing on providing adequate case time to our existing clients to ensure their safety and prevent premature discharges.
- **Waitlist Management**: Our waitlists have grown too high, and we need to manage the highrisk clients we currently have whilst building up the capacity to take on new referrals again.

What to do if you have an older person referred to you?

If you have an older person who needs support during this period, please redirect them to the appropriate services listed below:
